Word Focus...

Words/Phrases to Review: Kindergarten, Hello, Packs, Good Morning!, Gets Ready, Wakes Up, Brushes Teeth, Rushes to Dress, Ties Shoes and Hugs Goodbye

Activity Ideas

1. As you read the story, **comment** using action phrases and talk about how this teacher planned ahead. Talk about what your child’s teacher might have done to plan for their class.
2. Use the internet or visit the library to explore more books about school. These books will help your child begin to share their school experiences with you. **Expand what they say by adding language/structure** to make it more complete.
3. Help your child **take the perspective** of their teacher. What kinds of things would they do if they had a classroom? Have them draw what their classroom would look like.
